APR Standardized Data Elements

What's in it? Information stored in Banner (organized into three broad categories of Faculty, Students, and Registration/Curricular)

When will I receive it? Beginning summer 2015, chairs/directors will have continual access

How do I access it? Tableau dash-board via the web

Academic Finance

What's in it? Information related to budgeting, including aggregate salaries

When will I receive it? Early in the summer before your APR year

How do I access it? It will be sent via email from the Director of Assessment or the Director of Academic Budgeting

Library/Learning Commons Data

What's in it? Number of students receiving library instruction, number of sessions offered, number of research guides created with number of hits on those web guides, number of individual research consultations, and numbers from learning commons tutoring (if applicable)

When will I receive it? When you ask for it

How do I access it? Email the Library Director and request it

Career Services

What's in it? Job titles, employers, and median salaries for students by major

When will I receive it? Continual access, updated annually

Campus Ministry

What's in it? Names of students who have pursued a year of service
When will I receive it? Early in the summer before your APR year
How do I access it? It will be sent via email from the Director of Assessment

What's in it? Names of faculty who serve as primary advisors and second readers on Senior Honors Projects; faculty teaching in Honors (3-credit courses, 1-credit courses); honors courses offered in departments (for the old Core), and majors graduating in Honors from various departments

When will I receive it? Early in the summer before your APR year

How do I access it? It will be sent via email from the Honors Director or the
